Individual Events (total 12 events):

- ◆ Recurve men, 70 meter Round + Elimination Round
- ◆ Recurve women, 70 meter Round + Elimination Round
- ◆ Compound men, 50 meter Round + Elimination Round
- ◆ Compound women, 50 meter Round + Elimination Round
- ◆ Recurve cadet men, 60 meter Round + Elimination Round
- ◆ Recurve cadet women, 60 meter Round + Elimination Round



Gold Game:

An additional individual event held right after the end of ranking round. Every archer shoots 1 arrow per end and the best one wins eventually. Awarded in 3 categories:

- ◆ Recurve (distance: 70 meter)
- ◆ Compound (distance: 50 meter)
- ◆ Recurve cadets (distance: 60 meter)



Team Events (total 7 events):

- ◆ Recurve men team
- ◆ Recurve women team
- ◆ Recurve mixed team
- ◆ Compound team
- ◆ Compound mixed team
- ◆ Recurve cadet team
- ◆ Recurve cadet mixed team



Formation of Teams:

Teams can be formed of people who:

- ◆ belong to same archery club
- ◆ live in same city
- ◆ belong to same sport-organization
(national federation does not count)

For recurve seniors - we have separate men team and women team. For compound and cadet teams - it is necessary to have 3 team members. Gender is not important.

Entry fee:



The evening is accompanied by games, music and some dancing. Place where to meet old friends and find new ones.



Location:

Competition takes place in central Estonia, in Järvakandi.
Järvakandi is situated in Rapla county - 75 km from capital Tallinn, 50 km from Pärnu.
Closest airports are Tallinn and Riga.
There is a bus connection between Järvakandi and Tallinn/Pärnu.



Getting there:

In case you need help with organizing transportation from airports or marinas (Tallinn has connection with Helsinki and Stockholm), **do not hesitate to contact organizers.**
Transportation fees depend on nr of people and route.

Accommodation

There are many different options - see also our webpage. There are 2 options within walking distance from the competition field (school hostel and youth center), but also some possibilities for private accommodation.

If you come by car, then within 40km radius selection is bigger.

School hostel in Järvakandi

Basic accommodation with price of 7-10€ per person.

Shared toilets and showers are located at the end of corridors (separate for men and women). Rooms are with different size, from 2 persons to 5 persons.

Contact organizers to check availability of different rooms.

First come, first serviced principle.

Youth center in Järvakandi

This newly renovated building offers basic rooms with price 10€ per person per night.

Shared toilets and showers are located at the hall.

Rooms are with different size and bed types.

There are beds which are a bit shorter than usual - or for longer people - possibility to sleep on normal sized double-mattresses.

Contact organizers to check availability of different rooms.

First come, first serviced principle.

Jõe Guest House in Rapla

Located in Rapla, a bit less than 30km from Järvakandi.

Different room types and prices. Served in English, Russian and Finnish. Also possible to request breakfast service.

The JÄRVAKANDI OPEN is held already for 46th time. This tournament was named as “Järvakandi Grand Prix” and also “Järvakandi lahtised” in the past. It was also a well known competition in Soviet Union. Now, for the 7th year it is also named as Toomas Kivilo memorial competition.

In past 10 years there have been archers from following countries: Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Russia, Belarus, Poland, Ukraine, Germany, Finland, Sweden, Norway, and USA.
